1. Welcome, Introductions, and Review/Approval of September 23, 2025 Meeting Minutes

Update: NYSERDA CEC grant status: Given the remaining \$55,400 in grant funding from the two Clean Energy Communities grants we've applied for, and that have been approved, after deducting the \$4,600 cost of the required energy audit from the initial grant (Initial grant of \$10,000 - \$4,600 = \$5,400, plus the second grant award of \$50,000), Todd Martin's inclination and support regarding energy efficiency measures that we could afford, after meeting with him to discuss these, are as follows:
 - * EEM-1 Interior Lighting Retrofit: L&S estimated project cost = \$307, to be completed in-house;
 - * EEM-3 Insulate Building Envelope: L&S estimated project cost = \$33,682
 - * EEM-5 Install Double Glazing: L&S estimated project cost = \$9,400
 - * EEM-2 Building Airflow Reduction: L&S estimated project cost = \$5,456;
Energy Audit Estimated Total Pre-Bid Cost = \$48,845

Due to the likely cost beyond the resources through the available grant funds, the following EEM recommendations would likely not be able to be addressed at this time, absent additional funding:

- * EEM-4 Insulated Doors: L&S estimated project cost = \$25,384
- * EEM-6 Install Clean Heating System - Air Source Heat Pump: L&S estimated project cost = \$73,487
- * EEM-7 Install Clean Heating System - Ground Source Heat Pump: L&S estimated project cost = \$151,991
