

RESOLUTION 21 of 2026

At a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Clinton, held at Town of Clinton Town Hall, 1215 Center Road, Rhinebeck, New York, on the 12th day of June, 2026, at 6:30 p.m.,

Town Supervisor, Michael Whitton, called the meeting to order, and upon roll call, the following were present:

Councilperson Werner moved the following resolution, seconded by Councilperson Mustello to wit:

WHEREAS, Stonehouse Wood Sanctuary, petitioner in a Tax Certiorari proceeding brought in 2025 pursuant to Article 7 of the New York Real Property Tax Law, against the Town of Clinton, the Assessor for the Town of Clinton and the Town of Clinton Board of Assessment Review seeking a reduction of the 2025 assessment for the following property located in the Town of Clinton designated by tax identification number 132400-6369-00-634277-0000 (Stonehouse Road), and

WHEREAS, the attorney for petitioner, Karen E. Hagstrom, Esq., of Stenger, Glass, Hagstrom, Lindars & Iuele, LLP and Shane J. Egan, Esq., of Cappillino, Rothschild & Egan, LLP attorneys for the Town of Clinton have entered into a tentative settlement agreement of the Tax Certiorari proceeding, whereby the property would be exempt from taxation under Section 420-a of the N.Y. Real Property Tax Law due to its use as a wild life sanctuary:

Egan, Esq., to enter into a settlement agreement with the attorney for petitioner, Glass, Hagstrom, Lindars & Iuele, LLP, Karen E. Hagstrom, Esq., the terms of which are set forth in the attached Consent Judgment and hereby authorizes the attorney for the Town of Clinton, Cappillino, Rothschild & Egan LLP, Shane J. Egan, Esq., to sign said Consent Judgment on behalf of the Town of Clinton.
