Agreement for the Expenditure of Highway Moneys

AGREEMENT between the Town Highway Superintendent of the **Town of Clinton, Dutchess County, New York**, and the undersigned members of the Town Board.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the State for State Aid for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$_____ shall be set aside to be expended for primary work and general repairs upon _____ miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or renewals thereof.

2. PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the permanent improvement of Town highways:

(a) Longview Rd - On the road commencing at __Pumpkin Lane__ and leading to Shadblow Lane__, a distance of __.96__ miles, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ __220,660.00__.


